## **FUCHSIA DESCRIPTIONS**

## Joyce Forward

Single, H2, Trailer (Forward, UK, 1989) Tube & Sepals; Pink. Corolla; Petals Scarlet, the medium to large single flowers are carried on naturally trailing stems and will make a very attractive basket. Foliage; Med-Green on the upper surfaces and Green flushed with Red on the lower ('sport' of 'Coachman')

# <u>Carol Nash</u>

Double, H2, Bush (Dyos, UK, 1992) Tube; Medium-length and White. Sepals; White, tipped with Green, crepy on the underside, medium and broad . Corolla; A full White, slightly flushed with Pink. Petals are short and the blooms medium-large in size, Upright strong grower.

H1 Rather tender and frost shy. For perfection requires the winter protection of a heated greenhouse and temperatures in excess of  $7^{0}$  throughout the year.

H2 Described as half-hardy and may require some protection during winter.

H3 Described as hardy and can be planted permanently in the garden and will withstand normal winter conditions

This is a monthly competition for novices only (members who have not won a first prize in any fuchsia show). The competition runs from February to July and the trophy will be awarded at our annual show to the competitor gaining the most points.

Competitors are required to present their entry at our monthly meeting by staging them on the tables provided.

The monthly entry requirements are:-

February; One plant breaking into growth.

- March; Three rooted cuttings ready for potting. Rooting system to be seen, along with a sample of the potting compost.
- April; Two young plants stopped for bush or shrub growth.

May; Two plants grown for 3.5" pot class.

June; One plant in 5" pot shown for growth and cleanliness.

July; One plant in bloom any size pot up to 7".

Points awarded each month are 1st-4 pts., 2nd-3 pts., 3rd- 2 pts., All other entries 1 point Judges Committee. To maintain enthusiasm up to the end of competition the monthly results will not be
