Sanson

Double, H2, Trailer (Peterson, USA, 1957)

Tube & Sepals; Pink.

Corolla; Petals Dark Plum Purple fading to Pink..

Foliage; Variegated Pale Green and Pale Yellow.

The large flowers are freely produced. Naturally trailing in its habit so will make a good basket.

Denham Vale

Single, H3, Bush (Goulding, UK,19984)

Tube; Short and Orient Pink

Sepals; Horizontally held, Rosy Pink.

Corolla; Mauve, Extremely floriferous.

Foliage; Small, Matt Green

Neat, self-branching, bushy growth. Makes a superb small standard.

- H1 Rather tender and frost shy. For perfection requires the winter protection of a heated greenhouse and temperatures in excess of 7^o throughout the year.
- H2 Described as half-hardy and may require some protection during winter.
- H3 Described as hardy and can be planted permanently in the garden and will withstand normal winter conditions
